

PUBLIC HEALTH ORDER 13-2021
PURSUANT TO INDIANA CODE § 16-20-1-25

In light of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and the recent surge of positive coronavirus cases resulting in the latest seven-day positivity rate well above the desired 5% or less, I hereby direct this Public Health Order to the Marion Circuit Courts, Superior Courts, and all Marion County Small Claims Courts. This Public Health Order is effective immediately and remaining in force until superseded or rescinded.

1. The Marion Circuit, Superior, and Small Claims Courts must social distance of at least six (6) feet in any of their court facilities.
2. All visitors to the Marion Circuit, Superior, and Small Claims Court must wear a mask or face covering over their nose and mouth.
3. Employees must wear a mask and social distancing of at least six (6) feet is required unless in their own office alone or are fully vaccinated. Employees who share office space with other staff members and interact with the general public must continue to wear a mask regardless of their vaccination status.
4. This Order is necessary to cease conditions that contribute to the transmission of COVID-19 within the court system.

All other Public Health Orders related to the COVID-19 pandemic remain in force, except to the extent they are inconsistent with this Order. This Order is issued pursuant to Indiana Code § 16-20-1-25.
