AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

The undersigned, being duly sworn upon his oath, deposes and says as follows:

1. That the undersigned is a law enforcement officer employed by the Kosciusko County Sheriff's Office and assigned to the Kosciusko County Prosecutor's Office Investigative Division. This affidavit is made after conducting my investigation and consulting with other law enforcement officers.
2. On Saturday, November 12th, 2022, at 8:06 p.m. Warsaw Police Officer Bohnke responded to a personal injury collision at the intersection of US 30 and Center St. Warsaw, Kosciusko County, Indiana. Upon arrival, Officer Bohnke discovered that the collision involved a 2006 Freightliner Tractor Trailer and a 2008 International School Bus. The operator of the 2006 Freightliner was contacted initially by Kosciusko County Sheriff's Deputy Stringfellow who spoke to and identified the tractor trailer driver as VICTOR SANTOS, DOB: 02/10/1964. SANTOS advised that he was traveling west on US 30 when a school bus came out in front of him, and he struck it. Deputy Stringfellow asked VICTOR SANTOS to step out of the vehicle and when he did so SANTOS stumbled out of the truck. Deputy Stringfellow could detect the odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from SANTOS' person. VICTOR SANTOS was read his Miranda Rights and he agreed to speak with Law Enforcement.
3. Officer Bohnke spoke to VICTOR SANTOS about the collision and could detect the odor of an alcoholic beverage. Officer Bohnke also observed SANTOS' eyes to be red and glossy in addition to SANTOS' speech being slurred and slow. Officer Bohnke asked VICTOR SANTOS to complete standardized field sobriety testing and SANTOS consented to those tests. VICTOR SANTOS' performance on the field sobriety testing led Officer Bohnke to believe SANTOS was intoxicated at the time of the collision.
4. Officer Bohnke advised VICTOR SANTOS the Indiana Implied Consent and SANTOS refused to submit to a chemical test for intoxication. Officer Bohnke applied for and was granted a search warrant to obtain a sample of blood to complete a certified test for intoxication from VICTOR SANTOS. The search warrant was executed and a sample of blood was obtained from VICTOR SANTOS at Lutheran Kosciusko Hospital Lab on November 12th, 2022, at 9:18 p.m. for certified testing.
5. VICTOR SANTOS was booked into the Kosciusko County Jail and during the booking process, SANTOS provided a portable breath test sample indicating that VICTOR SANTOS had a .13% BrAC.
6. Officer Bohnke interviewed Julie Czucker and Charles Toscano who were traveling behind the Freightliner Semi Tractor Trailer. Czucker and Toscano advised that they began to follow the Freightliner in the area of

Interstate 69 and US 30 in Indiana. Czucker and Toscano advised that they sped up due to the Freightliner's driving behavior, but sometime later noticed the semi tractor trailer catching up from behind at a high rate of speed. The Freightliner passed Czucker and Toscano on US 30 straddling the yellow line in the middle of the roadway forcing them off the side of the road. Czucker and Toscano followed and paced the Semi as they neared Warsaw traveling between 80 and 85 miles per hour. Czucker and Toscano reported the Freightliner as a reckless driver, and followed behind the vehicle with their hazard lights on. Czucker and Toscano observed the Freightliner approaching the red light at the intersection of US 30 and Center St. Warsaw, Indiana. The Freightliner's brake light illuminated momentarily, and then the Semi continued into the intersection without slowing down, running the red light, and striking the school bus that was turning left on the green arrow.

7. Officer Bohnke spoke to Faith Lozinski and Brandon Conners who were traveling behind the Freightliner Semi Tractor Trailer. Lozinski and Conners began following the Freightliner Semi near Columbia City on US 30. Lozinski and Conners advised the Freightliner was traveling in excess of 90 miles per hour at times. Lozinski and Conners advised that the light at US 30 and Center St. Warsaw, Indiana, was red for westbound traffic, and a school bus began to make a left-hand turn across US 30 crossing the intersection. Lozinski and Conners stated that the Freightliner did not attempt to swerve to miss the bus or apply the brakes to avoid the collision with the school bus.

8. The 2008 International Bus was operated by Everett Shelton who was turning left from eastbound US 30 onto Center St. Warsaw. Everett Shelton had the green turn arrow and was traveling across westbound US 30 onto Center St. when the International Bus was struck by a westbound Freightliner. The bus was overturned as a result of the collision causing extensive damage to the bus and multiple injuries to the passengers. A.A, B.B., and C.C. were transported to Lutheran Hospital Fort Wayne for critical care treatment for their injuries as a result of the collision. All other patients were treated locally for injuries sustained in the collision.
